COST: FREE for all students! However, students must either bring their own lunch or purchase a school lunch. In addition, students may want to bring money to purchase items at the theater concessions.

EXPECTATIONS: All students must have a signed permission slip. All students must be on Level 1 or 2 to participate in this activity. According to our Level policies, students on Level 3 must be accompanied to the activity by their parent. The parent must have current volunteer clearance and HIB training. Students on Level 4 or who are suspended from school any time after May 1, 2018 are not allowed to participate in the 8th grade activity. **Permission slips will be collected in the office on June 4th, 5th, and 6th (Monday – Wednesday).**
